Christ is Risen! He is Risen Indeed! Hallelujah!

Easter was early this year. Easter is scheduled for the first Sunday, after the first full moon, after the vernal equinox. This year the vernal equinox, when day and night were of equal length, was March 19. The full moon was March 25. That's why Easter was March 31.

The weather has been cold. No new summer clothes this Easter. When the weather is cold in early spring, flowers last longer. Daffodils, forsythia, hyacinths, crocuses tend to bolt and die back as soon as the temperature gets warmer. As soon as the days are warmer though, the cherry trees bloom. Years ago, A.E. Houseman in his poem, A Shopshire Lad 2, wrote:

Loveliest of trees, the cherry now Is hung with bloom along the bough, And stands about the woodland ride Wearing white for Eastertide.

Now, of my threescore years and ten,

Twenty will not come again,

And take from seventy springs a score,

It only leaves me fifty more.

And since to look at things in bloom
Fifty springs are little room,
About the woodlands I will go
To see the cherry hung with snow.

The King James Version of the Bible (Psalm 90:10) describes "the days of our years (as) threescore years and ten; and if by reason of strength they be fourscore years, yet is their strength labour and sorrow; for it is soon cut off, and we fly away." Next week we should see spectacular displays of cherry blossoms along the roadside in Staten Island, or at Moravian Cemetery, and Snug Harbor. Remember to look at them.
