Merry Christmas.

We are in Christmas season, twelve days—December 25 through January 6—Christmas through Epiphany. One story says that the Magi set out on December 25 following the star and arrived in Bethlehem a year and 12 days later. The Bible doesn't say that though.

The gospel according to Matthew describes how Wise Men from the East followed a star to Bethlehem stopping first in the capital city, Jerusalem, to see the child born King of the Jews. When King Herod found out, he directed the wise men to find the child and then return to tell him where the child was so he could go and worship also. When the wise men didn't return, King Herod killed every baby boy in Bethlehem under the age of two thereby killing the upstart "king." Traditional Roman Catholic Churches remember the martyrdom of the Holy Innocents on December 28.

Moravians in Bethlehem, Pennsylvania have a longstanding tradition of building a putz, or display of the Christmas story using small figures. The Christmas Fair that we used to hold at Great Kills Moravian began as a putz.

After 40 days, Mary and Joseph took their son to the Temple for Mary's ritual purification after childbirth and to present their firstborn son to the Lord. There they encountered two old people, Simeon and Anna. Luke 2 records the beautiful prayer, the song of Simeon: "Lord, now lettest thou thy servant depart in peace, according to thy word: for mine eyes have seen thy salvation, Which thou hast prepared before the face of all people; A light to lighten the Gentiles, and the glory of thy people Israel."

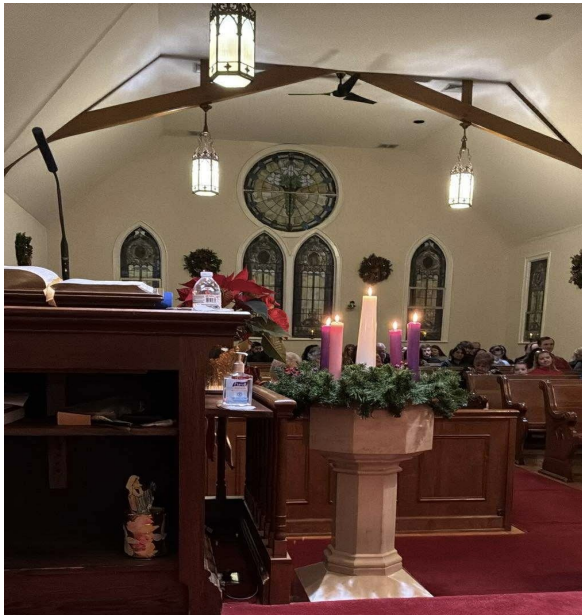
